"§ 1. Ius patronatus personale transmitti valide nequit ad infideles, publice apostatas, haereticos, schismaticos, adscriptos societatibus secretis ab Ecclesia damnatis, nec ad quoslibet excommunicatos post sententiam declaratoriam vel condemnatoriam.

§ 2. Ut ad alios ius patronatus personale transmitti valide possit, requiritur consensus Ordinarii in scriptis datus, salvo legibus foundationis itemque praescripto can. 1470, § 1, n. 4.

§ 3. Si res, cui ius patronatus reale cohaeret, ad aliquam personam de qua in § 1 transeat, ius patronatus suspensum manet."
